

Employee & Corporate Awards

United Way of Northeastern SD uses the following award system to recognize outstanding corporate and employee support. A company or employee group is eligible for the award if there are at least five (5) employees and if the company has completed its campaign and turned in the results to United Way by December 31st.

If your company qualifies for an award, you will receive it automatically from the United Way office. The printed certificates are ready to frame and hang in your lobby or reception area.

The awards are based on per capita giving and are as follows:

CORPORATE CAMPAIGN AWARD

Presented to companies that donate a minimum of \$30.00 per employee.

AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE

Presented to employee groups which attain per capita giving of \$100.00 or more.

GOLD AWARD

Presented to employee groups which attain per capita giving of \$75.00 to \$99.00.

SILVER AWARD

Presented to employee groups which attain per capita giving of \$60.00 to \$74.00.

BRONZE AWARD

Presented to employee groups which attain per capita giving of \$50.00 to \$59.00.

EMPLOYEE CAMPAIGN AWARD

Presented to employee groups who achieve a dollar total of at least \$200.00 and have an increase of 20% over their previous campaign. This award also applies to employee groups of five (5) or less.

EMPLOYEE LEADERSHIP AWARD

Presented to individual employees contributing \$250.00 or more.

RAILS CLUB AWARD

Any donor who gives a leadership gift of \$500 or more is eligible for a wooden plaque as a thank you. Their name will also be listed in the Rails Club brochure.

“GIVE FROM THE HEART” AWARD

Presented to the top three companies with the largest increase in giving over the previous year. The winners are presented with a plaque at the Campaign Rally and their picture is hung in the United Way office with previous winners. Because this award is given based on increase percentage giving, company size is not an objective.
